- **Embassy of Finland Chancery, Washington, D.C.** Located at 3301 Massachusetts Ave., N.W., the structure is a 108,000 square foot multi-use diplomatic facility of six floor levels (2 below grade). Includes 100-car below-grade parking and numerous retaining walls, site structures and monumental stair.
- **Embassy of Nigeria, Washington, DC.** Located at 1633 16th Street, NW, the structure is a new chancery building for the Nigerian Embassy in Washington, D.C. In addition to three above-grade levels of office and meeting space, the Chancery includes below-grade parking for 90 cars, with a total of 40,452 square feet.
- **United Arab Emirates Chancery, Washington, DC.** Located at 3522 International Court, N.W., the structure is a 107,800 square foot, six-level concrete reinforced building.
- **Embassy of Greece Chancery, Washington, DC.** Located at 2217 Massachusetts Ave., N.W., the structure has seven floor levels (three are below grade). Elevated floors are 3,000 square foot each and there is 7,500 square feet of ground and below-grade parking.
- **Embassy of the Philippines, Washington, DC.** Located at 1617 Massachusetts Ave., N.W., the building is a multi-use diplomatic facility.
- **Office and Residences, Embassy of the Arab Republic of Egypt, Office of the Egyptian Defense Attaché, Washington, DC.** Located at 26th and L Streets, N.W., this is a 95,000 square foot residential building with below-grade parking.
- **Royal Embassy of Saudi Arabia/Office of the Military Attaché, Washington, DC.** Structural renovation design and construction documents performed for the U.S. Army Corp of Engineers, Baltimore District.
- **Embassy of Germany: Ambassador's Residence, Washington, DC.** Structural engineering and construction documents for various site structures at the Ambassador's Residence.
